



Rug WonderGrip Underlay

ANCHOR YOUR RUG SECURELY TO ANY FLOOR SURFACE TO STOP FROM BUNCHING, MOVING OR SLIDING

We offer underlay pads for rugs and runners to prevent slipping, allow extra comfort and extend the rug's life. Underlays are used beneath your rug on soft or hard floors (carpet, timber, laminate, tile, concrete and stone); and on heated floors up to 31degC and on carpet.

Why do we highly recommend an underlay for every rug?

- They minimise trip hazards.
- They stop your rug from bunching, creeping or sliding - which also ensures safe walking.
- Underlay soaks up ripples and irregularities in flatwoven or thin rugs.
- The soft cushioning adds extra support for rugs, ensuring fibres on the underside are looked after and the rug is more comfortable to walk on.
- Protects the foundation and back of your rug.
- Measuring 3 mm in thickness, it provides additional walking comfort while satisfying the highest demands.
- Newly sealed floors must be completely dry and cured before laying any rug or rug pad.

Notes

The underlay will be the same size as your rug. Custom sizes are available, and include circular shapes.

Fibre & Construction

- Fibre: Needlefelt, with light adhesive finish on both sides.
- Height: 3 mm (1/8").

Composition

- 100% polyester fibres.
- 340grams of fibre per sqm.

- Prevents rugs from creeping.

Underlay Installation Guide

1. Make sure the floor is vacuumed, clean and dry.
2. Mark the position of the rug.
3. Lay the underlay inside the marks to your desired measurement.
4. Ensure the pad is approx 20mm smaller than the rug edge.
5. Place the rug on top of the underlay.
6. For oversized rugs, the underlay will be comprised of multiple pieces.
7. Underlay can be trimmed using scissors as necessary.
